### Poisonous Crops

Apple seeds, eggplant leaves, potato sprouts and green parts, tomato (green parts), rhubarb leaf blades; ; apricot, cherry, peach and plum: leaves, twigs, seeds

### Poisonous Wild Plants

Baneberry, buttercup, castor bean, hemlock (marsh and "poison"), marsh marigold, nightshade, skunk cabbage, western poison oak.
